The Announcement of Narathiwat Province The policy of morality and transparency to prevent corruption

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According to the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand (interim), B.E. 2557 (2014), Official Information Act, B.E. 2540 (1997), Good Governance Administrative Act, B.E. 2546 (2003), National Anti-Corruption Strategy Phase 3, B.E. 2560-2564 (2017-2021), and government policies of Article 10, Encouragement of State Administration which has good governance, anti-corruption, and misconduct in public office refer to well based standard of what is right or wrong which prescribe the value what human beings ought to do, interms of moralities, ethics, and conscious of retaining the dignity of civil servants and being honest. Those acts also relate to effective government management to prevent corruption and misconduct of officials at all level to meet the needs of people facilitation in order to build confidence in the bureaucratic system.

Therefore, Narathiwat prescribes the policy of morality and transparency to prevent corruption as a standard to be regulated and to be valued for government officials and all government employees in order that they abide by rules and regulations and other terms. The aim of this policy is to lead organizations to carry out the mission with transparency, management with honesty, integrity, Anti-Corruption. In order to achieve this policy Narathiwat prescribes guidelines for government offices, government agencies, all districts offices, and all sub-district offices in Narathiwat Province to be known and abided by strictly as follows:

1. Administrate and abide by good governance principles to meet the needs of people facilitations with fast, accurate, equitable, transparent and fair services.

2. Set values and attitudes to personnel in the organization having knowledge, understanding, ethics, morality and can apply King Bhumibol's Philosophy of Sufficiency Economy to use in the work and life.

3. Procure and promote the transparent implementation at all level and also open the opportunity for the private sector, civil society, and the public sector in monitoring the operation by publicizing the implementation information in all activities to them. 4. Do not seek personal or other benefits and not to give or receive property or other benefits, unless the receipt of property or other benefits in accordance with the rules of the Office of the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC)

5. Persuade people by complaint through Narathiwat Damrongtham Center when finding fraud clues

6. In cases of finding corruptions, they will be investigated, hardest punished and carried out seriously.
